Zeus – “The God of Sky, Thunder, and ruler of the Olympians.” It is said that Zeus was the greatest of the Greek Gods. The same could be said about the Zeus line of deep jigging blanks. In the traditional realm of deep jigging, there are likely no other blanks better suited for the battles waged against trophy size game fish. The Zeus lineup has a variety of actions for the discerning jig fisherman. Unlike other jigging blanks on the market, the Zeus line is made up of models specific to certain sizes and styles of jigs. They are typically for the larger size jigs and have the power to not only move the jigs and employ the correct actions, but also to dominate the fish and not the fisherman. These blanks are designed with moderate actions, significant back-bone, and are short in overall length to maximize the leverage an angler can put on a fish. All Zeus blanks are composite in construction and because of this have extraordinary durability and strength.

Originally from Downey, he, his wife, and children now reside in the beloved "SurfCity" California. The story of his fishing addiction begins

with Gary as a very young boy fishing off of his Aunt and Uncle's private dock on Balboa Island. By the ripe old age of 8 he became a private boater owner. He acquired a little dinghy from which he could be found fishing the Newport Harbor. Like so many youth of the day who loved fishing, he progressed through the ranks. He was a pier fisherman, a barge fisherman, and when his parents felt he was ready, became a sportboat fisherman. He fished all over Southern California from Redondo Beach to Dana Point. Next came the overnight fishing, short range fishing in the 2-5 day range, and finally, Long Range trips as he ascended to the pinnacle of fishing. By the early 1990's he was headlong into a massive gear build up for Long Range fishing when first came his wife and then kids. Fishing in general took the back seat to school functions, weekend hockey, and all the other activities that a great father like Gary must attend.

Gary has always possessed a creative mind. His parents would have even gone as far as to call him an artist from a young age. Drawing, sketching, doodling, and
